\* [Dumitru Fărcaș](#), in 1990 he was visiting California to make a dollar-two from the Romanians living in the Los Angeles area. He gave shows for a hundred or two parishioners at [churches](#) in the Los Angeles area ([here](#) and ... [there](#)) according to all sorts of [religious traditions](#) and [small, serious revelry](#) after the parishioners made their *last cross*. Angela, who was *the chef* at the Mignon restaurant at the time (after doing his apprenticeship for the first six months in America in a restaurant [like this](#) of a Frenchman, Gerard) about three years until she found her way to America! Here at Mignon gave performances for about a few dozen clients, big names in Romanian music; I only saw [Gigi Marga](#) and [Dan Spătaru](#), whom I met when he was like in this picture at Știința București, but Angela told me that she listened between two [filet mignon](#) with which Marinuș's restaurant and Mrs. Coca's gained its reputation so that on his return to Romania, after the fall of Ceausescu's communism, the restaurant was bought by a French owner who kept the name of the restaurant created by some Romanians who they put their hands up and the talent (especially artistic) became a good selling name! There at the [Mignon restaurant](#) (a stone's throw from [Sunset Blvd.](#)) [Corina Chiriac](#), [Constanatin Drăghici](#) and others about whom the Romanian communist newspapers wrote about their *remarkable successes* in their tours of America after the shows were invited to one of those who, for any special occasion or just to spend the rest of the evening with the group of friends had the house open for them!

At the end of each party they would sell a CD, two and each would pay on a CD as much as his *soul* held; generous as are all the Romanians I was friend with, we gave a hundred, some guys two hundred dollars on a CD.

I met Dumitru Fărcaș at my friend from Sibiu, Aurel Enescu, at Aurel's house in [Beverly Hills!](#)

Aurel and Dumitru have known each other since the time when Enescu was doing his technical studies in [Cluj-Napoca](#) and they met, not [there](#) but [here](#) for exchanges of *opinions!*

In 1991, when Sandu-Alexandru, Angela's brother, turned 43 in February, Enescu and Fărcaș were invited by Sandu to our home in [Buena Park](#). Sandu, as he liked to say, had come to America like Robin Williams & Al Pacino from *another planet!* Buena Park was inside the heart of what everyone knew [Orange county](#) is and is even today! [The greatest Romanian taragotist](#) poured his longings on his enchanted taragot, true Sânduc, true Aurel, true Dan (dentist, Dan Panoff had come to California with Dana his wife to visit relatives and they had decided to throw away the return ticket; Dan did his *apprenticeship* as a specialist in optimizing glass cutting on [NC cutting machines](#), on [Bystronic](#) at Downey Glass Co., in the department I supervised and it didn't *go away from my mind* until I was able to learn [BASIC](#) language with which I created the [Bystronic codes system](#), with which I began my *professional independence* in America.
